- The dance is from 7:30 until 10:00 pm.
 - Doors open at 7:30 and close at 8:30 pm. NO late entry or re-entry.
- **The theme is NO longer a masquerade. It is a spring theme.**
- If a student wishes to bring a guest who does not attend Snyder, she (it's Sadie Hawkins) must fill out a guest approval form (couple = 1 girl and 1 boy). Forms are available.
- Your guest approval form **must be submitted for approval** to Dean Kellum by Thursday, April 4th at noon.
- Any questions about dance attire may be directed to Ms. Pichardo or Mr. Kellum until Friday, April 5th at 3:00 pm.
- The school reserves the right to deny entrance to the dance or ask students to leave the dance if attire or behavior does not comply with the rules.

Spring Formal Dance Dress Code:

LADIES: must wear a semi-formal dress (Sunday best) or dressy blouse with skirt or dress pants. Attire must be modest and in line with school policy. Cleavage must **NOT** be exposed. **NO** plunging necklines or backless styles. **NO** exposed tattoos. Spaghetti straps and strapless styles are permitted, but must provide ample coverage. **NO** midriffs should be exposed (includes sheer or lace material). Dress / skirt must be age-appropriate, and the length must be **no shorter than four inches above the knee**. Slits in longer dresses must not rise above the tops of the knees. **NO** form-fitting dresses. Proper undergarments must be worn but not visible.

GENTLEMEN: must wear long-sleeved, button-down shirt, with white undershirt, tie, dress pants, or khakis and dress shoes. Pants must be worn belted at the waist. Blazers and suits are optional. Athletic and skate shoes are **NOT** permitted. Baseball caps and other casual headwear are **NOT** permitted. **NO** jewelry allowed. Sunglasses are **NOT** acceptable. **NO** exposed tattoos. **NO** facial hair.

NO ONE will be admitted into the dance without proper attire.

Dancing Rules:

NO public displays of affection or removal of proper attire. Physical contact will be monitored by the chaperones, including but not limited to the following: no grinding / back-to-front contact; no legs wrapped around another person; no hands on private parts; no sexually suggestive moves; no kissing. Any students who are not in compliance or who show disrespect to the chaperones will be asked to leave the premises. Further disciplinary action may be taken upon returning to school. All Snyder students with a guest are responsible for communicating all guidelines to their non-Snyder guests. There are no refunds.
